



## **Dr. David L. Di Maria**

Vice Provost for Global Engagement, University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC)

David L. Di Maria is an international education scholar-practitioner with more than two decades of experience supporting the international dimensions of teaching, research and service. He currently serves as the Vice Provost for Global Engagement at the University of Maryland, Baltimore County (UMBC). Prior to joining UMBC, Dr. Di Maria held international education leadership positions at Montana State University, Kent State University, and St. Cloud State University. Beyond his administrative leadership, he has directed international development and service projects for Rotary clubs in three states and served as a faculty member, developing and teaching graduate courses focused on international education leadership and intercultural communication. Dr. Di Maria has authored or edited more than 50 publications, including five books. He is also an active leader in the field, having served as president of AIRC: The Association of International Enrollment Management, chair of NAFSA's International Education Leadership Knowledge Community, and faculty for AIEA's Leadership Academy. His recent honors include receiving NAFSA's Annual Award for Outstanding Contributions to the Field of International Enrollment Management in 2021, being appointed to the Maryland/Washington, D.C. District Export Council by the U.S. Secretary of Commerce in 2022 and being named among North America's 50 leading voices in international education by PIE News in 2023. Dr. Di Maria earned an Ed.D. in educational policy and administration from the University of Minnesota, where his research focused on campus services for international students. He also holds a B.A. in International Studies and English, and an M.Ed. in English from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro.
