Glenn E. Good is the Dean and Professor at the University of Florida's College of Education since 2011. Dean Good has quietly and steadily guided the college to new heights. Under his leadership, the college's graduate programs routinely rank #1 nationally, its research expenditures now exceed \$133 million annually, and its fundraising and operating budgets have grown to support a vibrant community of over 1,200 employees. His scholarly record—five books, more than 90 peer-reviewed articles, and 225 conference presentations—has garnered over 13,000 citations and an h-index of 53, reflecting a significant impact across academia and beyond. Reflecting his commitment to collaborative innovation, he has served in leadership roles in numerous national organizations, including AERA, APA, CADREI, and LEARN. He has been recognized with national awards for research, teaching, mentoring, and service, and is a Fellow of four Divisions of the American Psychological Association.

Outside of academia, he enjoys cycling, hiking, snorkeling, and spending time with his wife, Dr. Laurie Mintz, and their two daughters, Jennifer and Allison.
