Dr. Panthi is an Associate Professor in the Department of Construction Management, where he also serves as the Graduate Program Director for Construction Management. More recently, he has assumed the role of Director of the PhD Program in Architecture, Urbanism, and Built Environments (AUBE). Dr. Panthi brings over 25 years of combined experience in research, teaching, and the construction industry. His teaching areas include Construction Management Risks and Global Management of Construction. He is a recipient of Morgan State University's Outstanding Faculty Award for Teaching. His research interests span risk management, energy retrofitting, safety management, and innovative and sustainable construction materials. His research is centered on construction project risk analysis, including safety, with the aim of quantifying project impacts. He has published more than 50 articles in peer-reviewed journals and conference proceedings and has secured research grants from multiple funding agencies.

Dr. Panthi currently serves as an Executive Board Member of the Construction Management Association of America (CMAA), Baltimore Chapter, where he acts as the Student Chapter Liaison. He previously served as Chair of the Graduate Curriculum Committee at Morgan State University and currently serves as a committee member. He is also an editorial board member of the Journal of Built Environment Project and Asset Management (Emerald Group Publishing), where he received the Outstanding Reviewer Award in 2014.
